2008-2009 RE Classes and Curricula

- PreK through Grade 1 will be learning from the UU Alphabet curriculum. This class will explore self, community, and UU identity through stories, activities, and affirmations.

- Grades 4 and 5 will be learning from the Tapestry of Faith Toolbox of Faith curriculum. They will learn what “tools” Unitarian Universalism can provide for them to face the challenges of life. These lessons will be supplemented by lessons from Holidays and Holy Days.
